7-9 I-20 and Melges 17 Championships 11-12 GLSS X 13 - GLSS Opti Rolex President and CEO, Stewart Wicht presented Annie Haeger of Lake Beulah with her prestigious award noting the qualities of Rolex - integrity, excellence and endurance. After spending a lunch with both Annie and Steve Benjamin, he recognized the same qualities in the 2015 recipients of the Rolex awards.

The affair itself is phenomenally impressive from the NYYC itself with all its history and artifacts; the congregation of US's finest sailors and promoters; the exquisite attention paid to detail with dinner, decorations, momentos for attendees; the generous sponsorship by Rolex and, lastly, to the acceptance speeches themselves.

Annie Haeger is the second youngest recipient of the award; Benjamin the oldest. The contrast in the speeches provided a view into the career of a sailor. Yet, the similarities abounded - the dedication to the sport, the teams required to achieve goals, the personal sacrifice, the "endurance" mentioned by Rolex. It was an emotional expression of gratitude from both.

Annie's love for Lake Beulah and the ILYA was evident. Her large "entourage" in attendance spoke volumes about those who have supported, followed, challenged her. She is one loved young lady. JJ Fetter, four-time YOY, introduced Annie and beamed at the opportunity to welcome another 470 sailor into the fold. Additionally, she remarked on the rapid rise to the top in a boat with such technical complexity.

The most poignant moments came when thanking her parents individually her dad for mentoring, supporting and someone for who she works to make proud; her mom, for setting a moral standard and teaching her to be kind in all situations. A direct quote from Will and Annie Haeger - "she's a saint". Past ILYA Commodore grandfather Milt Haeger beamed, beamed, beamed as he celebrated Annie's accomplishments and his 80th birthday in NYC.

And no less proud than her parents were the 25 of her Lake Beulah friends who could barely contain themselves.



Combine two events on one weekend. Want to give the Board your opinion (constructively, of course)? Want to meet Dave Berg? It's all located conveniently for you March 12-13. The Wayzata YC is the site of the Judges



course. Then travel east to the weekend's hotel (<u>Crowne Plaza hotel near Mall of America</u>) for dinner with arriving Board members and Dave Berg. Many folks of all levels of sailing proficiency took the course last year. They all came away with an appreciation for running a protest meeting. Remember, protest committees are usually comprised of three individuals. You all bring differing knowledge and understanding to the hearing. Now is the time to start to feel comfortable volunteering as a judge in that hearing. Bruce Martinson is expert but brings teaching down to all levels. He makes it seem straightforward. There were nothing but kudos from last years' courses east and west.
