Barkow is first female to receive Tour Card

The World Match Race Tour (WMRT) is the longest running, global, professional sailing series, pitting the world's best sailors against each other in one-on-one combat style racing. For the first time in it's 22-year history the WMRT has awarded a tour card to an all-female team for the 2016 circuit.

As a breeding ground for some of sailings most famous names with previous champions including Russel Coutts, Sir Ben Ainslie, James Spithill and Dennis Conner, the World Match Race Tour has attracted



applications from across the globe.

"We're incredibly excited and honoured to be awarded a Tour card for the 2016 season. It's been a dream of ours to race on the World Match Race Tour for over a decade. Now finally, the time is right. We have built a strong international team and after racing around the world, we can't wait to get back out on the water," comments skipper Sally Barkow, USA.

The WMRT all-female team is not new to the sport of match racing, with over six World Titles between them as well as Olympic and Volvo Ocean Race successes. Earlier this year, as part of Team SCA, they sailed into the history books, being the first female team to win a leg of the Volvo Ocean Race in twenty-five years. "This is an amazing opportunity for women in sailing, and sport in general. There are not many sports where women have the chance to compete and perform in the same field as men. During the Volvo Ocean Race we proved that women can and should be seen as serious competitors and we hope to continue this legacy into the World Match Race Tour." Annie Lush, GBR, Trimmer.

As part of The Magenta Project, the all-female team hopes to inspire others to follow in their path, making an impact further than just the racecourse with involvement in community and charity events alongside competing on the Tour and are currently looking for a commercial partner to support them in their sailing and charity endeavours.
