This is a popular PFD in youth sailing but is NOT legal for participation in our events. Please resurrect your old PFD's, borrow one or purchase a new PFD prior to our busiest youth regatta season. All X and Opti boats and sailors' equipment is subject to measurement prior to the registration at the event.
