NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

- 1.1. The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2. Appendix T - ARBITRATION of the *Racing Rules of Sailing* will apply.
- 1.3. The INSA and SCWSA Rules will apply.
- 1.4. Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows: the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced with a One-Turn Penalty.
- 1.5. All boats shall carry the following equipment: a paddle, bailer, painter, wearable personal floatation device, and a whistle.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1. The regatta is open to all Senior (over 18) Naples Sabot sailors in the following divisions: Women's A, Men's A, Women's B and Mixed C.
- 2.2. To enter boats shall comply with RRS 75.1.
- 2.3. Eligible boats may:
 - a. Enter online by completing the entry form on line and paying the required entry fee online no later than 1600, Friday, November 12, 2021, on the SDYC website at: www.sdyc.org/scwsa
 - b. Enter in person on the day of the regatta at registration during registration hours and pay the race day entry fee.
- 2.4. To constitute a fleet or division, each fleet or division shall have a minimum of three (3) entries. The RC may at the RC's option combine the starts of fleets with less than five (5) entries. Scoring will be separate.

3. FEES

Required fees are as follows:

Prepaid Competitor entry, including dinner:	\$40.00
Prepaid Non-Competitor entry (dinner only):	\$35.00
Race Day Competitor entry, including dinner:	\$45.00
Race Day Non-Competitor entry (dinner only):	\$40.00

4. SCHEDULE

- 4.1. Saturday, November 13, 2021

0930 to 1100	Registration
0930 to 1100	Continental Breakfast
1100	Skipper's Meeting
1200	Warning Signal for first race

Each succeeding race will follow the prior race as soon as reasonably possible.

- 4.2. Up to five (5) races are scheduled for this regatta.
- 4.3. There may be a short break after the third race.

5. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available online and during registration.

6. RACING AREAS

The racing area will be in La Playa Cove between SDYC and SWYC, or the Channel between Shelter Island and the mainland.

7. PENALTY SYSTEM

Rule 44.1 will be changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty will be replaced by a One-Turn Penalty.

8. SCORING

8.1. Appendix A will apply for this regatta, and the SCWSA Rules will apply to the SCWSASeries Scores in addition to Appendix A. Any conflict between the SCWSA Rules and Appendix A will be resolved in favor of the SCWSA Rules.

8.2. One (1) race is required to be completed to constitute a regatta.

8.3. When fewer than five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. When five (5) races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

9. PRIZES

Awards for this regatta will be given for each division.

The Connie Melhorn Perpetual will be awarded to the woman or man from any yacht club who has the lowest score in this regatta.

The Ruth Bown Perpetual will be awarded to the SDYC woman with the lowest score in this regatta.

10. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See rule 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta.
