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Summary: Per Gross weight Rule, item C concerning minimum weight of the Clydesdale Division, I propose to change the minimum weight to 190-195 pounds in lieu of 225 pounds.

All Fleet races and all races sponsored by the Association shall be governed by the racing rules of the International Sailing Federation World Sailing as adopted by the national authority of the nation in which the race is held.

- C.1 For Senior Championship Regattas, Clydesdale Division, the gross weight of the skipper must be ~~225~~ 190 or 195 pounds or heavier.
- C.2 modify weight limits accordingly

Reasons: The participation within the Clydesdale Division has been minimal. Lowering the weight limit will encourage more sailors to participate.
