Registration Process

- Early Bird registration runs February 1-March 31 and offers a \$100 discount for regular program and \$50 discount for the Junior Buccaneers
- Regular registration runs from April 1-June 16

- Complete online registration via MYC Jr Sailing website
- A \$100 non-refundable deposit is required at the time of registration with the remaining balance automatically charge on May 1 if not paid before.

Fees Include: Daily instruction, use of facilities, program costs, program shirts, boat storage and JSA membership.

Non-member fees includes "C" class member fee which includes use of pool and snack bar as well as ability to participate on the swim team for the season.

Important FAQs

- We work to accommodate all skill levels and interests of children in the program.
- We combine adventure sailing with race training to expose children to all aspects of the sport.
- We attend regattas throughout the JSA and will work to help any child that wishes to attend an event.
- You will need to provide your own boat or charter a boat from MYC or another vendor such as the Boat Locker or the Dinghy Locker.
- We have Optis and 2 C420s available for seasonal charter on a first come, first served basis.
- All children will need to pass an annual swim test at the start of the program.
- All of our instructor staff are fully certified through US Sailing and also have First Aid/CPR and Safe Powerboating certification.
