SDAYC COMMODORE'S 2024 MESSAGE

The San Diego Association of Yacht Clubs (SDAYC) was founded in 1960 for the purpose of fostering and encouraging participation in yachting and to promote public interest in those activities in the San Diego Area.

Encouraged by the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA), Yacht Clubs throughout the area form Harbor Associations under the umbrella of SCYA to organize boating at the local level. SDAYC is one of five Harbor Associations whose responsibilities reach as far north as Moro Bay and San Luis Obispo. All remain affiliated with SCYA.

Many affiliate clubs with the Yacht Racing Union, the genesis for the United States Sailing Association. Other important boating organizations also work side-by-side with the Harbor Associations under the SCYA umbrella.

Recreational Boaters of California (RBOC) was formed to represent all boaters and clubs in the State before the Legislature in Sacramento. The Pacific Coast Yachting Association serves all clubs and associations from Canadian Clubs in British Columbia to California clubs near the Mexican border. We are all part of a vital boating community, and we have much in common.

SDAYC's officers and directors are chosen from the ranks of Staff Commodores from member clubs. We should all be grateful to those individuals for their continuing service.

In 2023 the Board decided that it was worth trying a different format at a couple of the regular monthly

meetings. At Southwestern Yacht Club, during the summer, there was a seminar on 'gaining, training and retaining a Race Committee'. In the fall, at Mission Bay Yacht Club, the seminar covered the policies and problems encountered by Port Captains. Both events proved successful, and we

hope to repeat them or develop other seminars for the 2024 season.

A topic of deep interest to all clubs are their junior programs. Clubs already collaborate in their efforts, and I wonder if SDAYC might provide a venue for deepening the awareness of these programs to club officers. We encourage you to offer suggestions for SDAYC to develop in service to all Clubs.

Every membership meeting provides an opportunity to socialize and get to know officers and members of other clubs. Many useful friendships have

developed there. It seems that no matter what difficult situation a club encounters, another club has had to deal with something similar and advice is readily shared. The regular monthly meetings always provide interesting and informative presentations significant to San Diego area boaters.


Our meetings also provide a useful forum for announcing events to all the clubs. They also help secure support from other member clubs for special events. For example, the Wheelchair Regatta secures support from several clubs to provide a bay cruise to our challenged guests. The annual Christmas Parade of Lights secures volunteers to station their boats around the parade route as picket boats to guide participants. Similarly, for the Big Bay Boom fireworks on Independence Day, July 4, perimeter boats are essential to control the safety area around the fireworks barges.

San Diego is home to a great number of good programs, sailors, boaters, and volunteers. They deserve to be honored. This year,

your Board of Directors is committed to increasing the relevancy and inclusivity of the Association. A very high priority will be actively promoting our awards program. In fact, this issue of the Racing Calendar will feature some of the honorees for 2023.

All clubs should be proud of their members accomplishments. Beyond the honors bestowed upon them by their own club, SDAYC has a range of awards. These awards serve to honor deserving individuals before our entire community.

San Diego Bay Parade of Lights

The San Diego Bay Parade of Lights is a time-honored tradition brought to the San Diego Bay by the boating community. Each year, more than 80 lavishly decorated boats proceed around the San Diego Bay on two consecutive Sundays in December.



The San Diego Bay Parade of Lights brings more than 150,000 San Diego residents and visitors together on the San Diego Bay waterfront each year. The procession of 80 to 100 uniquely

decorated boats has become one of the region's most iconic holiday events and has brought the community together

for 53 years.

The parade route has been the same for the last six years. It starts at Shelter Island and travels east past

Harbor Island, then south along the Embarcadero, Seaport Village, and Cesar Chavez Park before turning parallel with the Coronado Bridge to the west side of the bay. The parade then proceeds past the Coronado

Cortez Racing Association

Cortez Racing Association (CRA) was founded in 1980 by sailboat racing enthusiasts on Harbor Island in San Diego Bay. It has grown to be an influential race organization and is a non-profit, sanctioned Sailing Association whose purpose is to promote sailboat racing and other sailing-related activities in the San Diego area.

CRA is run entirely by unpaid volunteers serving approximately 250 members. Their spirit of “giving back” drives them to dedicate time and effort for the cause of improving, expanding, promoting and glorifying the sport of yacht racing.

CRA's members keep their boats at various locations throughout the San Diego area. Many members are also members of other Yacht Clubs throughout Southern California.

CRA's elected Board of Directors meet monthly to discuss racing matters, organizational logistics, and to plan future events. The Board's goal is to continually improve the quality of CRA through competitive racing and other activities. Board meetings are open to all CRA members.



This is the largest competitive sailing event in the region. In addition to the Beer Can series, CRA also runs 12 races annually, usually one per month.

CRA has established close ties to other important sailing organizations. These include the US Sailing, the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA), the San Diego Association of Yacht Clubs (SDAYC) and the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (PHRF). These relationships, together with ties to all the local Yacht

Clubs, ensure that CRA members are welcomed at regattas throughout the region.

In late 2022 CRA was gifted a 32-foot Grand Banks by racing legend Dennis Conner. Christened “Dennis Conner”, this boat serves as the signal boat for all of the CRA races.

CRA is greatly appreciative of Mr. Conner's generosity and support of the club's activities. CRA shares the Dennis Conner with Southwestern Yacht Club in exchange for a slip at a nominal cost.

CRA works closely with PHRF of San Diego and now offers multiple rating systems for regattas including ORR and ORC. CRA races attract more handicap racers than any other organizing authority in San Diego.

We invite all sailors to join CRA and enjoy the most exciting racing on the bay. CRA welcomes new members to help run the Association by serving on the Board of Directors and by volunteering for Race Committee.

Race Committee is a great way to broaden a sailor's understanding of tactics and strategies that can provide an edge the next time they are jostling for a front row start. See you on the water!

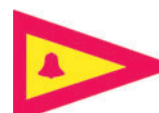

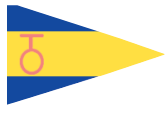

Sportsmanship Award HERSHMAN SAVES THE RACE

As sailors do, and as sailors have done over the centuries, George Hershman came to the assistance of others when in need.

On June 8, 2023, the *T/S Cal Maritime*, a 77-foot racing sloop, crewed by cadets from the Cal State University Maritime Academy was berthed in Cabrillo, California. The crew was preparing for the biannual TRANSPAC Race to Hawaii. Just days before for the start of the race the cadets were busy preparing and



practicing. Ashore was its trailer holding parts and most importantly, the suite of sails necessary for a long ocean race. Sometime during the night, the trailer, sitting in the parking lot of the marina, was stolen. Not for

the value of the contents but simply for the value of the trailer. The value of the sails ran into the hundreds of thousands of dollars. And the time required to build new sails did not bear thinking about. The sailing team, that relies on donations to compete, simply could not afford to replace the stolen sail inventory.

News of the loss spread like wildfire through the sailing community. Cal Maritime was out of the race unless sails could somehow be found. News of the disaster reached San Diego Yacht Club member George Hershman, owner of the *Good Energy* - a 63-foot racing sloop competing directly against the Cal Maritime yacht.

Hershman was able to determine that his sails for the *Good Energy*, with some modification, were a good match for the stolen sails needed by the Cal Maritime. Without hesitation, he gave sails from *Good Energy's* inventory, including headsails, spinnakers, and staysails, so the cadets could make the race.

George Hershman well deserves SDAYC's Sportsmanship Award.

Alonzo de Jessop Award 2023 JOHN ADRIANY

John Adriany, from San Diego Yacht Club well deserves this award for outstanding service to yachting. Adriany is an active sailor and racer. However, it is his work representing the Shelter Island Master Leaseholders Group (SIMLG), an informal association of Port tenants operating marinas in the basin. On behalf of the group, he directed the response to the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) of copper from anti-fouling paint that has earned him



SDAYC's Alonzo de Jessop award. In February of 2005, the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board (RWQCB) adopted the Shelter Island Yacht Basin (SIYB) TMDL to address concentrations of

dissolved copper in the basin. Levels of dissolved copper exceeded the California and Federal protective standard. The TMDL required the Port, SIYB marinas and boaters berthed in Shelter Island to reduce copper levels to achieve the standard. This was to be accomplished by reducing the amount

of copper entering the water column from anti-fouling paint by seventy-five percent over seventeen years. The ultimate threat to the yachting community arising from the TMDL was the possibility that boats would have to be removed from the basin. This included boats that were using legal copper bottom paints approved by the California Department of Pesticide Control.

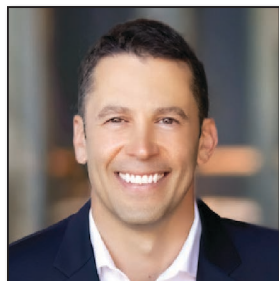
Adriany was instrumental in forming the SIMLG. His group's intention was to respond to orders from the RWQCB and from the Port of San Diego to document the types of paint used on every one of the 2000 boats in the basin. Adriany, a biochemist, designed

I've been racing close to 200 days per year, on all sorts of different boats, for as long as I can remember. My ability to transition from class to class and team to team is, I would say, a result of my work ethic."

Challenged Sailors San Diego - Adaptive Sailing

In 2018, after retiring from a career in US Air Force flight test, Dale Burchby started volunteering with Challenged Sailors San Diego.

Burchby has sailed for almost 50 years and loves volunteering to share the sport with a wide range of folks in a variety of disability situations – CP, MS, quadra/para and TBI. Many are military veterans who have endured significant disabilities from service.

Some days Burchby is introducing a newcomer to the freedom and beauty of being in control of the boat, enjoying the wind. On other days he doesn't even touch the helm as he accompanies an experienced sailor with disabilities who

once thought they would never be back on the water.

"I love the freedom that our team, fleet and equipment make possible for

sailors. It's beyond what most adaptive sports can provide. Taking a person out of a wheelchair—or whatever their situation is—and giving them total control of the boat is fantastic. And they race and win!"

Racing reminds Burchby that speed is a relative concept. During flight testing he flew at Mach 1.6. That is 1,800



feet per second.

"In contrast during our last regatta, my sailor who we had to hoist into the boat from his wheelchair found

himself on a downwind leg side-by-side with two other boats, each of them one boom's length apart. The boat to starboard was being piloted by a sailor who was deaf, also uses a wheelchair and has other challenges. The boat to port was being sailed by a blind person. Each of them were doing everything they could to achieve one

additional foot per minute to be first to the leeward mark. And that was fun."

Volunteering with CSSD is the first opportunity Burchby has taken to really get to know people with disabilities. Adaptive sailors deal with tough situations but are matter of fact and uncomplaining. These friendships have helped Burchby interact with others in a more mindful and empathetic way.

Challenged Sailors San Diego is always looking for new volunteers. They sail every Friday and Saturday, year-round. Many thanks

to all the generous donors who make it possible. This is the only adaptive sailing program in the United States that sails every weekend.

and administered a system of collecting and reporting hull-paint information. He was a zealous advocate in SIMLG's dealings with the Port and the RWQCB. His scientific background and expertise underpinned SIMLG's efforts to address flaws in Port studies and analysis. It also challenged the flawed assumptions made in the TMDL itself.

In 2021 Adriany organized a science project group of students and an instructor from San Diego High Tech High School. They developed "Oyster Condos" that were installed on the docks at all three of the Yacht Clubs in the basin. Oysters process

large volumes of water and provide several benefits. They are very sensitive to copper and they naturally clean water in their habitat. The project was designed to demonstrate that copper levels were not having a negative effect on sensitive species. Adriany obtained permission from the Port to establish the condos and kept the RWQCB appraised of the project. The students were fully involved in the design, deployment, and monitoring of the "Oyster Condos."

Toward the close of 2022 the RWQCB acknowledged that TMDL would not achieve the reductions in dissolved copper that were mandated.

Adriany guided the SIMLG response to both the Port and to the water board.

As a result, the TMDL is now in hiatus. The RWQCB is reconsidering its approach to achieving a "Healthy Bay." This more sensible approach should be welcomed by all San Diego boaters.

Because of Adriany's work the worst possible outcomes, including slip closures and curtailed operation of boatyards, has not been implemented.

Every boat owner in the bay owes a great deal to John Adriany for his untiring efforts.
