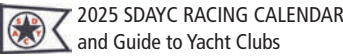

## San Diego Bay Parade of Lights

The San Diego Bay Parade of Lights is a time-honored tradition brought to the San Diego Bay by the boating community. Each year, more than 80 lavishly decorated boats proceed around the San Diego Bay on two consecutive Sundays in December.

The San Diego Bay Parade of Lights brings more than 150,000 San Diego residents and visitors together on the San Diego Bay waterfront each year. The procession of 80 to 100 uniquely



decorated boats has become one of the region’s most iconic holiday events and has brought the community together

for 54 years.

The parade route has been the same for the last six years. It starts at Shelter Island and travels east past

## New Art Of Navigation Exhibit Opens At Maritime Museum Of San Diego

*Treasured Tools. Refined Resources. Turning Intellect, Math, Nature & Science into Beauty*

### S.T.E.A.M. of the Early Days

The Maritime Museum of San Diego’s mission is to serve as the community memory of our seafaring experiences by collecting, preserving, and presenting our rich maritime heritage and historic connections with the Pacific world. The Museum is pleased to announce the opening of the new Art of Navigation exhibit this summer in the Gould Eddy Gallery found aboard the 1898 Victorian – era steam ferryboat Berkeley. Entry to the new exhibit is included with

K.C.I., President/CEO of the Maritime Museum of San Diego “As a powerful and mysterious art, navigation and the territorial claims of trade and empire it conveyed drew much of its authority and mastery from the same aesthetic as did all art. In consequence, the instruments, reference texts, and nautical charts which were its tools and products were therefore also objects of exquisite beauty.” Art of Navigation highlights artifacts used when the great voyages of European exploration began in the mid-sixteenth century at the dawn of the Scientific Revolution, oceanic navigation was one of the rare disciplines (along with military and mining engineering), in which mathematics and instruments found tangible and useful application. Even among many of the foremost scientists of that time, mathematics and instruments were thought to be impediments or distortions of the pure reliance on human observation that the ancient Greek philosopher Aristotle had argued as the basis for scientific investigation.

In the days before photography, exquisitely detailed landscapes and elevations of islands, coastlines, and harbor entrances not only provided vital navigational information, but they also rivalled the finest examples of contemporary landscape art. Among the first popular genres of non-fiction made available by the invention of the printing press to mass audiences, voyage accounts not only provided stirring narratives, but graphic renderings of strange places, animals, and peoples that held readers enthralled. Dr. Ashley adds, “The ships themselves were not only practical conveyances of cargo, people, information, and military might, but also of national prestige. Ships were designed to be just as beautiful as they were useful, since they were at the same time projections of power, identity, authority, and possession. In an age when baroque embellishment was a statement of wealth and power,



ships were among the most baroque embellished objects created.”

The Maritime Museum of San Diego is open daily at Star of India wharf located at 1492 N. Harbor Drive between Grape and Ash Street. Visitors can explore the floating museum of ships along the north embarcadero and multiple below-deck exhibits with one general admission ticket. General admission self-guided tour prices for adults are \$24.00, seniors, military, and students 13-17 are \$18.00 and youth 3-12 \$12.00. Children under two are free. Tickets may be purchased in advance at [sdmaritime.org](http://sdmaritime.org) or at the Museum Ticket Booth. \$10.00 daily 45-minute narrated Pilot boat Bay tours may also be added to admission, based on availability at 11:00 a.m., 12:45 p.m., 1:45 p.m. and 2:45 p.m. and (3:45 p.m. weekends only) tour times.

About the Maritime Museum of San Diego

The Maritime Museum of San Diego experience includes admission to a world-class collection of historic sailing ships, steam-powered boats, and submarine, each offering entertaining and educational exhibits. The 501c3 non-profit Museum enjoys an international reputation for excellence in restoring, maintaining, and operating historic vessels including the world’s oldest active sailing ship, Star of India. Maritime Museum of San Diego is ranked as one of the nation’s top attractions offering self-guided tours, docent guided-group tours, tall ship charters, year-round public events, educational programs, and a distinctive venue for corporate/private events. centers, Veterans Village of San Diego, San Diego Center for the Blind, Assisted Living Facilities and many more.

## Celebrating The Sea: Exploring The Maritime Museum Of San Diego’s Hidden Collections

### New Sea Centric Art Exhibit Opens

The Maritime Museum of San Diego, whose mission is to serve as the community memory of our seafaring experiences by collecting, preserving, and presenting our rich maritime heritage and historic connections with the Pacific world, announces the opening of the new exhibit Celebrating the Sea: Exploring the Maritime Museum of San Diego’s Hidden Collections in the Compass Gallery on the ferryboat Berkeley. Entry to the new exhibit is included with general admission. October 2024 through July 2025 visitors can revel in a rare and rich tapestry of treasured maritime-themed art and admire notable artists’ work, embracing the nautical world of breathtaking coasts, artifacts & treasured ships.

According to Maritime Museum of San Diego Librarian, and exhibit Curator, Kevin Sheehan, Ph.D., “It is estimated that globally less than five percent of museum collections are on display at any one time. That means most of the art and artifacts conserved in museums throughout the world are



held in storage. This is not surprising. Putting items on view can require significant planning, and exhibit space in museums is often relatively limited.” According to Raymond Ashley, Ph.D., K.C.I., President/CEO of the Maritime Museum of San Diego, “Here at the Maritime Museum of San Diego our

largest objects – the ships themselves – are very much in the public eye. But what of the smaller items – the ones that don’t necessarily fit into a themed exhibit? Our new exhibit, Celebrating the Sea, brings to light some of this hidden collection.”

The Maritime Museum of San Diego is open daily at Star of India wharf located at 1492 N. Harbor Drive between Grape and Ash Street. Visitors can explore the floating museum of ships along the north embarcadero and multiple below-deck exhibits with one general admission ticket. General admission self-guided tour prices for adults are \$24.00, seniors, military, and students 13-17 are \$18.00 and youth 3-12 \$12.00. Children under two are free. Tickets may be purchased in advance at [sdmaritime.org](http://sdmaritime.org) or at the Museum Ticket Booth. \$10.00 daily 45-minute narrated Pilot boat Bay tours may also be added to admission, based on availability at 11:00 a.m., 12:45 p.m., 1:45 p.m. and 2:45 p.m. and (3:45 p.m. weekends only) tour times.

## Cortez Racing Association

Cortez Racing Association (CRA) was founded in 1979 by sailboat racing enthusiasts on Harbor Island in San Diego Bay. It has grown to be an influential race organization and is a non-profit, sanctioned Sailing Association whose purpose is to promote sailboat racing and other sailing-related activities in the San Diego area. CRA is run entirely by unpaid volunteers serving approximately 250 members, whose spirit of “giving back” drives them to dedicate time and effort for the cause of improving, expanding, promoting and glorifying the sport of yacht racing.

CRA’s signature event each year is the summer Beer Can Series, organized jointly with Silver Gate Yacht Club.

Now in its 42nd year, this 10-week regatta kicks off right before Memorial Day and attracts more than 120 boats



each Wednesday evening to race in ten different classes on San Diego Bay, making it the largest competitive sailing event in the region. CRA also runs 12 races annually, usually one per month, in addition to the Beer Can series.

CRA has established close ties to other important sailing organizations.

These include the United States Sailing Association (USSA), the Southern California Yachting Association (SCYA), the San Diego Association of Yacht Clubs (SDAYC) and the Performance Handicap Racing Fleet (PHRF). These relationships, together with ties to all the local Yacht Clubs, ensure that CRA members are welcomed at regattas throughout the region.

We invite all sailors to join CRA and enjoy the most exciting racing on the bay. CRA needs members to come forward to help run the Association by serving on the Board of Directors and by volunteering for Race Committee work. Race Committee is a great way to broaden a sailor’s understanding of tactics and strategies that can provide an edge the next time they are jostling for a front row start. See you on the water!
