- 9. SDAYC Commodore's message —Happy to see fellow SDYC S/C here thanks for your support! For those of you who have not attended SDAYC meetings this year we have updated the dinner programs to make our SDAYC meetings more relevant and by having events where we collaborate and share information and ideas. Later in the meeting tonight, we will vote on a SDAYC Bylaw change. We will get to that under new business.
- 10. Introduction by SDAYC Commodore of tonight's program: Steering with Purpose Fundraising & Community Impact at SDAYC. For all of you who have been to SDAYC meetings the clubs have been sharing information about events and regattas, and we all talk about the amount of money we raise and the type of community events we put on. It is very impressive to hear about all of the community and military events, and the charitable and fundraising events. Tonight, our program will highlight how our SD area clubs support our community in a multitude of ways. We have a deep tradition of service and giving back to the community. Thank you to all the clubs for supplying your information about your charitable & fundraising activities and for providing pictures for the slide show tonight.

Our speaker this evening is Harvey Denman who has been working hard at analyzing the data collected to share with us in the program tonight. First, let me introduce Harvey, with his wife Jill. Harvey was born in Frankfurt, Germany in a military family and grew up in Houston. He was Commodore of Lakewood YC in Houston in 2005 and had served 11 years on their Board. We were lucky to have Harvey & Jill move to San Diego in 2015 where they have immersed themselves in SDYC activities and especially in our CMAC (Community & Military Appreciation Committee) and he currently serves as our sponsorship chair. In a prior life, although he is still involved, Harvey is a successful Corporate "fixer" – he knows how to analyze issues & solve problems! At this time, I will hand it over to Harvey for the presentation.

## Steering with Purpose – Fundraising & Community Impact at SDAYC.

Promoting seamanship, fellowship, and civic and community activities and advocating for boating and the maritime community is what SDAYC is all about. In 2024 the SDAYC coalition of yacht clubs across SD county have made quite an impact in their communities. Their events have supported veterans and active military, their communities through philanthropy and events that support our youth sailing. Several of our area clubs also have Club Foundations including SDYC, MBYC, SWYC, OYC and CYC.

In 2024, there have been over 50 different club sponsored events. These events often go unrecognized, yet the clubs are offering up their facilities and club assets such as boats, tables, chair, linens, podiums, sound equipment, tents and much more. They use club funds for supplying food and beverage and even to provide direct monetary donations. In addition, the clubs use their sailing instructors, administrative staff, support staff, maintenance staff and countless member volunteers to host these momentous events. The club membership also makes contributions through providing direct donation funds to support and cover costs to ensure a successful event.

16 Veteran/Active Military focused programs totaling \$83,575.

15 Philanthropic programs totaling \$823,623.

18 Community Support Events totaling \$25,250.

Preparing Future Generations Donations totaling \$199,000
