Flying Scot Fleet #111 and Lake Lanier Sailing Club (LLSC) cordially invite you to attend the 2026 Flying Scot Scotahoochee Regatta on September 19-20, 2026. This is the 2nd stop on the 2026 Flying Scot Fall Southern Circuit.

ELIGIBILITY:

Flying Scot sailboats from any District in compliance with class rules and who have completed all registration requirements including payment of the required entry fees will be scored for the Scotahoochee Regatta.

RULES:

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined by the 2025-2028 Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), the prescriptions of US Sailing, the one design rules of the Flying Scot Sailing Association (FSSA) and this Notice of Race except as amended by the Sailing Instructions. Sailing instructions will be provided on the regatta website and at check-in.

Rule 60.4 (a) (2) is changed as follows: "(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in, and did not see, the incident, or"

REGISTRATION:

The entry fee for Flying Scots is **\$110** and includes **2 FULL** weekend meal packages*
A discount of **\$10** is available for Flying Scot Sailing Association members.
A late fee of **\$20** applies to registrations made online or emailed after Tuesday, Sept. 15, 20.

RACING AREA:

Racing will take place in the vicinity of Chattahoochee Bay and the main channel on Lake Sidney Lanier northeast of Atlanta, Georgia.

LAUNCHING:

LLSC has two boat ramps for use, one in Lot A (closest ramp to the clubhouse) and one in Lot B (on left immediately after entering the gate).

COMMUNICATIONS:

The Skipper's Meeting and other Communications with competitors may be made using VHF radio. All competitors are encouraged to bring a VHF radio for use during the regatta.

PENALTIES:

A boat shall take a One Turn Penalty when she may have broken one or more rules of Part 2 in an incident while *racing*. This changes Rule 44.1.

SCORING:

The Low Point Scoring System in Appendix A of the RRS will be used to score the regatta. If 6 or more races are completed, the competitors highest score (worst finish) will be discarded in determining the competitor's total score for the regatta.

To be scored for a race, the competitor must finish the race within 30 minutes of the finishing time of the first boat to finish the race in her class.

A single race will constitute a regatta.

TROPHIES:

Trophies for the Scotahoochee regatta will be awarded to the skippers and crews of the top 5 finishing Flying Scots.

ACCOMODATIONS:

Great camping is available on the club grounds, located close to the clubhouse. Most sites have a picnic table, parking area. There several fire pits on club grounds. Showers are located near the Lot A launch ramp. A limited number of powered RV spots are available. Contact Kelly Bryant, kbryantg3@gmail.com to reserve.
