Supplemental Sailing Instructions (SIs) Amendment 1

The notation '[DP]' in a rule means that any penalty is at the discretion of the Protest Committee.
The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS Rule 60.1

1 RULES

- 1.1 The event is governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.
- 1.2 The class rules of each invited class will apply.
- 1.3 Rule 60.4(a)(2) is changed as follows: "(2) if it alleges a breach of a rule of Part 2 or rule 31 and is from a boat that was not involved in and did not see the incident, or"

2 CHANGES TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

- 2.1 Any written change to the sailing instructions shall be posted before 0900 on the day it will take effect, except that any change to the schedule of races will be posted by 2000 on the day before it takes effect.
- 2.2 Changes to a sailing instruction may be made on the water. If a change is made on the water the race committee shall announce the change by on the designated VHF channel and by voice.

3 COMMUNICATION WITH COMPETITORS

- 3.1 Notices to competitors shall be posted on the official notice board (ONB) located at <https://theclubspot.com/regatta/BDYleq39Ss>
- 3.2 On the water, the race committee intends to monitor and communicate with competitors on VHF radio channel 1078 (78A), or by voice.

4 CODE OF CONDUCT

[DP] Competitors and support persons shall comply with reasonable requests from race officials.

5 SIGNALS MADE ASHORE

When flag AP is displayed ashore, '1 minute' is replaced with 'not less than 30 minutes' in Race Signals AP.

6 MARKS & COURSES

See Addendum A.

7 OBSTRUCTIONS

- 7.1 For safety, each of the lines bounded by the following two points is an obstruction:
- (a) R “2” northwest of Coast Guard Island, and the closest point ashore.
 - (b) R “4” northwest of Coast Guard Island, and the closest point ashore.
- 7.2 The penalty for boats crossing a line that is an obstruction listed in SI 8.1 is to retire.

8 THE START

- 8.1 US Sailing Prescription APPENDIX U, Audible Signal Racing System, is in effect.
- 8.2 The starting line will be between an orange flag on the Signal Boat and an inflatable buoy.
- 8.3 [DP] Boats whose warning signal has not been made shall avoid the starting area during the starting sequence for other races.
- 8.4 The intended starting order for the first race each day is Mercury, Harbor 20, and Snipes. Subsequent starts will be determined by fleet status and announced by voice and radio.

9 THE FINISH

The Finish Line shall be between an orange flag on the SB and the Starting Mark.

10 PENALTY SYSTEM

US Sailing Prescriptions V1 is in effect.
