3rd Annual All Islands Youth Regatta (AIYR) and Scott Boye Memorial / Alumni Regatta

Sunday August 11th, 2024 Jackson's Beach, Friday Harbor, San Juan Island



NOTICE OF RACE & SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

1. ELIGIBILITY AND RULES:

- 1.1. This regatta is open to middle school, high school and high school alumni (plus guests) sailors.
- 1.2. All sailors must have successfully completed a capsize drill in cold water.
- 1.3. Sailors, coaches, and spectators must wear a USCG Level III lifejacket and suitable footwear whenever on the dock or in boats.
- 1.4. The regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

2. ENTRY:

- 2.1. To register, please sign up on the ClubSpot page, found here.
- 2.2. Registration closes Tuesday August 6th at 8 pm.
- 2.3. Each competitor must have a signed waiver on file. Please complete a waiver for each competitor here.
- 2.4. Fees are \$20 per sailor for participants in any of the San Juan Islands youth programs and \$40 per sailor for adult sailors.
- 2.5. This is a fundraising event for the San Juan Island Sailing Foundation, a 501(c)(3) organization. Donations will be used for the purchase of equipment for the middle and high school racing team.

3. BOATS AND FORMAT:

- 3.1. This regatta will be sailed in V15, FJ, ILCA 4,6,7 and RS Tera sailboats.
- 3.2. Boats will be provided by the Sailing Foundation for any sailors not bringing their own boats.
- 3.3. Register for your preferred fleet; race management may, with discussion, re-assign sailors to different boats based on capacity.
- 3.4. Sail numbers will be used to identify boats for scoring.
- 3.5. The course will be: Start, Windward Mark, Leeward Mark, Finish (see Appendix A).
 - RS Teras will use windward mark W1; all other classes will use W2.
- 3.6. Class flags and starting order will be determined once entries are in and will be communicated during the competitors meeting.
- 3.7. The start of the race will be indicated by a 3-minute musical horn countdown sequence.
- 3.8. Three horns at the start indicates general recall.

- 3.9. The start line is closed (restricted only cross when starting).
- 3.10. The finish line is closed (restricted only cross when finishing).
- 3.11. When five or more races are completed, a competitor's worst score shall be excluded. When 10 or more races are completed, a competitor's two worst scores shall be excluded.
- 3.12. The top three hulls in each fleet with the lowest scores for the regatta will receive recognition at the awards ceremony.
- 3.13. Races will be scored and published on the <u>ClubSpot page</u>.
- **4. SCHEDULE:** Any changes to the schedule will be announced at the competitors meeting. Sailors must be able to be present for the full day to compete.

5. RACING & SPECTATING AREA

- 5.1. All races will be sailed on waters directly off the Jackson's Beach, Friday Harbor.
- 5.2. Families can watch racing from Jackson's Beach.
- 5.3. Two public bathrooms are located opposite the Net Shed at the rigging area.
- 5.4. The Jackson Beach boat launch is a public launch. Sailors, coaches, families, dogs, and boats must not unduly interfere with other members of the public also using these facilities, and must be aware of the presence of vehicles, some of which will be towing boats, launching, and otherwise using the parking lot, so as to not cause injury or other mishap.

6. TRANSPORTATION & FOOD:

- 6.1. Teams are responsible for their own transportation. The address of the regatta site is: Jackson's Beach Road, Friday Harbor, WA. A map of the area can be found here.
- 6.2. Sailors should bring their own food, water and snacks to the regatta. Lunch is not provided, and restaurants/shops are a five-minute drive from the area. There is no source of fresh water at the launch.

7. COACHING:

- 7.1. Coaches may go afloat and coach sailors that need assistance to finish the race.
- 7.2. Race committee and mark boats will communicate on VHF Channel 72.
